

# Tomatoes — Cherry



## CHADWICK CHERRY

A perfect cherry for salads and snacking. Disease resistant vines set abundant crops of 1" fruits borne in clusters. Productive all-season. 70 days.



## GARDENERS' DELIGHT

German heirloom with clusters of deep-red 3/4" fruits. Excellent flavor. 70 days.



## JULIET\*

1 oz. cherry tomato hybrid with a great sweet flavor that produces grape-like clusters. Crack resistant. 60 days.



## MEXICO MIDGET

Hundreds of 1/2-3/4" dark red cherry tomatoes produced throughout the growing season. 60-70 days.



## PANDORINO\*

Vigorous, tall vines are covered early with multiple cascading clusters of cherry-bright, sweet fruits to harvest all summer long.

70-75 days.



## SWEETIE

Sweet, round red cherry with a high sugar content makes these tomatoes perfect for juice or preserves. 65-70 days.



## SEBASTOPOL

Large 3/4" red cherry tomatoes. Juicy, meaty and bursting with sweet flavor and a spark of tartness. Suited for cooler coastal regions, foggy climates and shorter growing seasons. 64-70 days.



## BLACK CHERRY

High yield, deep purple/mahogany fruits with rich, complex flavor. 75 days.



## BLACK PLUM

Larger than a cherry tomato. Great taste and very prolific. Starts early and lasts a long time. 80 days.



## CHOCOLATE CHERRY

These 1" cherries have an attractive port wine-colored flesh and skin with a comparably delicious and multifaceted flavor. Super productive. 70 days.



## VIOLET JASPER

1-3 oz. round fruits that ripen to a gorgeous, striped, violet-red-green color. The fruits have a characteristic mild and smooth flavor. Soft texture. Highly productive plants make it difficult to keep up with harvests. 78 days.

### AMY'S APRICOT

Growing in popularity due to its flavor, this tomato is a lovely golden apricot in color. Tall vigorous plants bear lots of ¾" fruit. Its flavor is usually compared to Sungold, fruity but intense. 75 days.



### BEAM'S YELLOW PEAR

Very sweet, 1½" yellow pear-shaped fruits have a mild flavor. Great for fresh eating or making tomato preserves. 80 days.



### SUN SUGAR\*

Attractive, golden-yellow color with extraordinary sugar-sweet flavor make this one a perfect gourmet cherry tomato! Thin-skinned, tiny, crack-resistant fruits. 62 days.

## Tomatoes – Dwarf



### DWARF BEAUTY KING

Very productive rugose, regular leaf dwarf-type plant. Its fruit are medium sized, oblate shaped, smooth skinned, and red in color with vertical, gold striping. 75 days.



### SUNGOLD\*

Hybrid with golden color, outstanding flavor, and good disease resistance; produces all season. 57 days.



### GLORIA'S TREAT

Rugose, potato leaves. One of the best flavored dwarfs, 6-12 oz. 75 days.



### ATOMIC GRAPE

Lavender and purple stripes, turning to technicolor olive-green, red, and brown/blue stripes when fully ripe. Crack resistant, developed by Brad Gates, Wild Boar Farms. 75 days.



### ROSELLA PURPLE

Regular rugose leaves, similar to Cherokee Purple. 75 days.



### KARMA PURPLE

Potato leaf cherry, producing dark purple fruits. So sweet, we call them garden candy. 75 days.



### TASMANIAN CHOCOLATE

Great 2-3' tall plant. This tomato has deeply ribbed 5-12 oz. fruit. 55 days



### BLUSH

Bright yellow with red stripes; excellent flavor. 70 days.

# Tomatoes — Early



## **BLOODY BUTCHER**

Very productive, all-purpose heirloom with rich flavor, blood red skin and flesh. 55 days.



## **EARLY GIRL VFF\***

Early slicing tomato with good disease resistance. Hybrid, flavorful, 4-6 oz. fruit. 57 days.



## **NEW GIRL\***

Earlier and more disease resistant than Early Girl. Hybrid, 4-6 oz. fruit. 58 days.



## **FIREWORKS**

Early, red slicing tomato with 6-8 oz. fruits. 60 days.



## **FOURTH OF JULY\***

Early maturing plant produces good yields of 4 oz. bright red tomatoes. Perfect for salads, sandwiches, and slicing. 50 days.



## **MOSKOVICH**

High quality, early season red heirloom that rivals hybrids. Great eaten fresh or processed. Highly resistant to cracking.

Semi-determinate. 4-6 oz. 60-75 days.



## **SILETZ**

The regular leaf plants of Siletz are early maturing and produce red fruit that are large (up to a pound), with the first to mature being nearly seedless (parthenocarpic). 70 days.



## **SIoux**

Early maturing plant produces high yields of 4-6 oz. red tomatoes. They are incredibly sweet, tangy, and full of those rich complex flavors that make a delicious tomato. 70 days.



## **STUPLICATE**

This cold-tolerant tomato ripens to sweet, red, slightly oval, 2" fruits and produces throughout the summer. 60 days.

# Tomatoes — Heirloom



## **BRANDYWINE (PINK) SUDDUTH STRAIN**

Also known as Pink Brandywine, this variety has an incredibly rich, delightfully intense tomato flavor. A beefsteak tomato that produces large pink fruits, up to 2 lbs. 90 days.



## **CASPIAN PINK**

The first tomato to beat Brandywine in taste tests! Large pink beefsteak. 80 days.



## **JULIA CHILD**

Beefsteak that produces deep pink fruits that are very flavorful, sweet, and juicy. Perfect for sandwiches, salads, and slicing. A Julia Child favorite. 78 days.



## **PINK BOAR**

2-4 oz. fruit, striking looks, outrageous flavor. 70-80 days.



## **BEEFSTEAK**

America's most popular variety for topping sandwiches. Large, meaty fruits with rich tomato flavor. 80 days.



## **MONEYMAKER**

Great for fresh eating! 4-6 oz. smooth fruits which do well in hot, humid climates. Very productive. 77 days.



## **OXHEART**

Heavy yielding vines produce extra large, pink tomatoes weighing 1-2 lbs. Firm, meaty flesh with few seeds and mild flavor. 88 days.



## **SUPER FANTASTIC\***

An improvement on the ever-popular FANTASTIC tomato with stronger disease resistance. Hybrid. Heavy yields of solid, meaty, smooth 10 oz. fruits. 70 days.



## **SUPERSTEAK\***

Our favorite super size tomato with most fruits weighing in at 2 lbs. Hybrid. Burpee bred, this is the original with "beefsteak" flavor and meaty texture. 80 days.



## **BRANDYWINE**

The nation's favorite heirloom tomato! Vigorous vines with big, globe-shaped fruits bursting with juicy flavor. Perfect to eat right off the vine or slicing for sandwiches. 80 days.



## **BURBANK SLICING**

Developed by Luther Burbank around 1915. Heavy yielder of majestic 3-4" fruit, very deep red color and a traditional bold flavor. 75 days.

### **CRIMSON CARMELLO**

Bred in France, the 4-5" red juicy fruits have a perfect sweet-to-acid balance that translates to exquisite taste. Disease resistance. 70 days.



### **ROSE DE BERNE**

Easy to grow dark pink 4-8 oz. tomato. Sweet, meaty Swiss heirloom. 75 days.



### **ANANAS NOIR (a.k.a. Black Pineapple)**

Gorgeous on the inside: green and dark reddish-brown with fuchsia stripes. Large fruits up to 1½ lbs. 85 days.



### **CHOCOLATE STRIPES**

3-6" mahogany colored flavorful fruit with olive green striping. 80 days.



### **BLUE BEAUTY**

Cross between 'Beauty King' and a blue tomato. Fruit is modest beefsteak-type slicer, weighing up to 8 oz. 80 days.



### **BLACK BEAUTY**

Darkest black tomato we sell with extreme anthocyanin expression. One of the best tasting tomatoes. 80 days.



### **BLACK BRANDYWINE**

Potato leaf. Extra large in size and full of the deep, earthy and sweet flavor that has made blackish-purple tomatoes so popular. 90 days.



### **BLACK KRIM**

Fruits are a dark, deep red (almost a shiny black) with heavy green shoulders. Interior is a deep, reddish-green color. Sweet and tasty. 80 days.



### **CARBON**

Large smooth fruit; one of the darkest and prettiest of the purple types. It has an extra dose of the complex flavor that makes dark tomatoes famous. 80 days.



### **CHEROKEE CARBON\***

A gorgeous dusky purple beefsteak with rich, complex flavor, this hybrid is a cross between two heirloom taste-test winners, Cherokee Purple and Carbon. 80 days.



### **CHEROKEE PURPLE**

Cherokee Indian heirloom; 10-12 oz. fruits, deep dusky purple-pink color. 80 days.



### **JAPANESE BLACK TRIFELE**

Heavy producer of delicious pear-shaped 4 oz. fruits that are free of blemishes and cracks and range in color from intense black to dark gray, blushed with magenta. 75-80 days.



### **PAUL ROBESON**

Russian heirloom that continues to be a favorite in taste test competitions. Brick red, 8-12 oz. fruits have dark green shoulders and red flesh. Exceptional flavor. 85 days.



### **PINK BERKELEY TIE DYE**

Port wine beefsteak with metallic green stripes and excellent flavor. 8-12 oz. Developed by Brad Gates. 70 days.



### **REBEL STARFIGHTER**

A beautiful heart shaped tomato with green, blue, red and black skin. Inside is rich burgundy-red flesh. Tangy, old-fashioned umami tomato notes. Fine, wispy foliage and grows with vigor. 70 days.



### **RED BOAR**

Small slicer 2-4 oz. fruit. Red colored mutation from Green Zebra. Top notch performer in look, taste, and production. 70-75 days.



### **SOLAR FLARE**

Beefsteak with 6-10 oz. red fruit with gold stripes. Brad Gates. 75 days.



### **AZOYCHKA**

A Russian heirloom that produces an abundant crop of smooth, 3", 10-16 oz., slightly flattened oblate, meaty, yellow/orange tomatoes with a luscious sweet citrusy flavor. 72 days.



### **BLUE GOLD**

2-3 oz. Blue and gold bright yellow tomato with tops that turn black with anthocyanin. Interior is red-yellow bi-color that is sweet and fruity. High production plant. Sunburn, crack resistant.



### **BEAUTY KING**

One of the best looking and tasting red and yellow bicolor striped tomatoes you'll ever try! Very sweet fruits up to 20 oz. have meaty yellow flesh with bright red streaks. 80 days.



### **GOLD MEDAL**

Good yields of 1-2 lb. bi-colored orange-yellow beefsteak tomatoes with some rosy-red coloring. Juicy with rich, sweet tomato flavor. 75 days.



### **JUANE FLAMME**

Prolific producer with bright orange 2" fruits with a tangy, sweet taste. 75 days.



### **KELLOGG'S BREAKFAST**

Orange beefsteak that produces fruits weighing 1-2 lbs. Fruits have a good acid/sugar balance and plants are very productive. 80 days.



### LUCID GEM

This Brad Gates selection was the winner of the sweetest tomato award at the 2017

National Heirloom Expo. 5 oz. very meaty fruits are yellow with black tops. 75 days.



### MUCHTAR'S MAGIC

The perfect yellow tomato and a Harvest for the Hungry Garden exclusive. 75 days.



### OAXACAN JEWEL

Pre-Columbian Mexican heirloom that produces beautiful 1-2 lb. yellow/red bicolor fruits and brilliant red marbling inside the flesh.

Wonderfully rich, sweet, fruity flavors with a well-balanced, acidic finish. 80 days.



### PINEAPPLE

Valued for its beauty, taste, and size. Beefsteak fruit with yellow exterior and interior swirls of red, pink, orange, and yellow.

Mildly sweet with low acidity. 90 days.



### CAPTAIN LUCKY

The hot, new tomato! Open pollinated, delicious, potato leaf plants. Green-bicolor. 75 days.



### GREEN GIANT

Large emerald-green, smooth, and blemish-free fruits over 1 lb. Color stays pure green, even

when dead ripe. Outstanding complex flavor. Very few seeds. 85 days.



### GREEN ZEBRA

Beautiful chartreuse with deep lime-green stripes. Flesh is bright green and very rich

tasting, sweet with a sharp bite to it. Just too good to describe! 75 days.

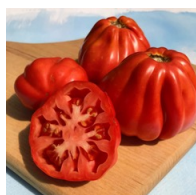

# Tomatoes — Paste/Sauce



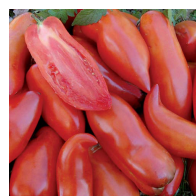
## AMISH PASTE

This classic paste tomato is flavorful and juicy enough for slicing, with great meatiness for cooking down. Very few seeds, medium size, sweeter flavor than other paste tomatoes. 74 days.



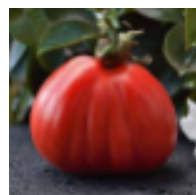
## CESARE'S CANESTRINO di LUCCA

A rare, indeterminate Italian heirloom brought from Tuscany by Chef Cesare Casella, featuring deep red, ribbed "little basket" fruits known for high sugar, low acid, and low moisture, making them exceptional for sauces. 90 days.



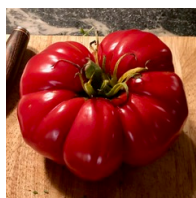
## FEDERLE

Produces tons of 7" long red tomatoes with a rich, balanced, delicious flavor profile compared to most paste tomatoes. 85 days.



## GOLDMAN'S ITALIAN AMERICAN

Pear-shaped meaty tomatoes. Intense red color and equally intense tomato taste. Meaty with few seeds. 80 days.



## GREEK

Produces large quantities of over 1 lb. fruit. Starts slowly, then begins to fill in with thick, leathery leaves and continues until frost. 80-90 days.



## OPALKA

Sweet, 5" tomatoes shaped like a banana pepper. Plants have wispy foliage but are very productive and vigorous. Few seeds, lots of sweet meat. 80 days.



## ROMA

**Determinate.** Oblong-shaped, small, red fruit that is meaty inside with few seeds. Well-suited for sauces, canning, drying, and making tomato paste. 75 days.



## SAN MARZANO

Red plum type, 2-3" long, 5-6 oz. traditionally the best choice for tomato sauce. 80 days.



## SAN MARZANO REDORTA

Named for a mountain in the Alps, San Marzano Redorta is considerably larger than its cousin at 4" long, 8-10 oz. Disease resistant. 78 days.



## SUPER ITALIAN PASTE

Produces an abundance of reddish orange, 6" elongated, firm tomatoes that average about 10 oz. each. The flesh is thick with very little juice and few seeds. 70 days.
